INTRODUCTION:

Nine times we read in the Gospel that Jesus said to his disciples, "Do not be afraid." Why did he have to repeat his so often? Is it still important for us today, to be strengthened against fear? We freely admit that we too, need to be told: do not be afraid!

GOSPEL: MATHEW 10: 26 - 33

Jesus said to the Twelve: "Fear no one. Nothing is concealed that will not be revealed, nor secret that will not be known. What I say to you in the darkness, speak in the light; what you hear whispered, proclaim on the housetops. And do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul; rather, be afraid of the one who can destroy both soul and body in Gehenna. Are not two sparrows sold for a small coin? Yet not one of them falls to the ground without your Father's knowledge. Even all the hairs of your head are counted. So do not be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows. Everyone who acknowledges me before others I will acknowledge before my heavenly Father. But whoever denies me before others, I will deny before my heavenly Father."

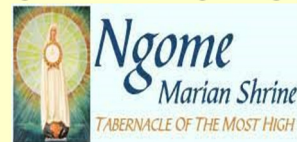

We pray that the international community may commit in a concrete way to ensuring the abolition of torture and guarantee support to victims and their families.

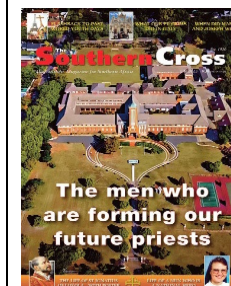
