INTRODUCTION:

We are afraid of storms. Lightening might strike our homes and winds might blow the roofs off, we are frightened. There are different kind of storms present in our world today. Wars, famine, sickness, oppression and persecution can sweep over a country like a fierce storm. We need to remember that Jesus is powerful. It was Jesus who commanded the storms, lightening and waves. This should give us courage in the storms that we face today. Let us ask ourselves: Why are we afraid? Do we not have faith?

GOSPEL: MARK 4: 35 - 41

On that day, as evening drew on, Jesus said to his disciples: "Let us cross to the other side." Leaving the crowd, they took Jesus with them in the boat just as he was. And other boats were with him. A violent squall came up and waves were breaking over the boat, so that it was already filling up. Jesus was in the stern, asleep on a cushion. They woke him and said to him, "Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?" He woke up, rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, "Quiet! Be still!" The wind ceased and there was great calm. Then he asked them, "Why are you terrified? Do you not yet have faith?" They were filled with great awe and said to one another, "Who then is this whom even wind and sea obey?"

SUNDAY REFLECTION BY BR CEBU



Life is full of storms. At times, they can become so strong and strange that our human strength can no longer support us. At such moments fear and complaints, he might take over the central stage of our life. Even in some cases, we might lose our faith in God, thinking that he has abandoned us, or that he does not exist. These storms come in different forms.

The overarching theme of the 12th Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year B, is about placing trust in God's power and presence, especially during life's storms and challenges. The readings call the faithful to recognize God's supreme authority over all creation and to have confidence in His ability to protect and guide us. It encourages believers to move from fear to faith, trusting in God's love and care even when circumstances seem overwhelming. This theme is encapsulated in Jesus' calming of the storm, serving as a powerful reminder of His divine power and the peace that comes from trusting in Him.
