SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT CYCLE C

INTRODUCTION:

How would you feel if you knew that soon you would have to suffer very severely and that your life would be in danger? If you knew that this suffering could not be avoided, what would you do? Would you not look for somebody to be with? Would you not look for any sign of hope? When Christ approached the time of his suffering, he received such a sign. On the mountain, while he was praying, God's glory became visible in him, Christ was transfigured and the father's voice was heard above him. Truly, a powerful sign of hope before the beginning of his suffering.

GOSPEL: LUKE 9: 28B – 36

Jesus took Peter, John, and James and went up the mountain to pray. While he was praying his face changed in appearance and his clothing became dazzling white. And behold, two men were conversing with him, Moses and Elijah, who appeared in glory and spoke of his exodus that he was going to accomplish in Jerusalem. Peter and his companions had been overcome by sleep, but becoming fully awake, they saw his glory and the two men standing with him. As they were about to part from him, Peter said to Jesus, "Master, it is good that we are here; let us make three tents, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." Fast from complaints; contemplate simplicity.

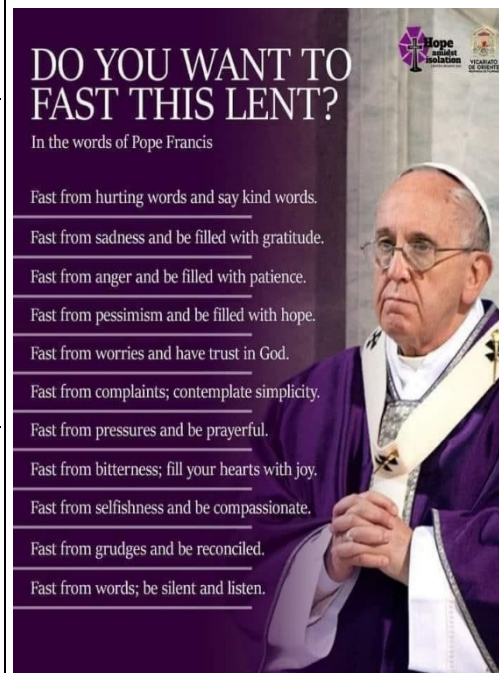
Fast from pressures and be prayerful.
